

Homeland Security laws require that all guests travel with government-issued photo identification (ID) (such as a driver's license) at all times. ID must be presented at the time of check-in. AQSC is required to provide all guests' ID information including ID number, expiration date, and place of issue to the Coast Guard and/or other government entities prior to the vessel's departure. Guests must provide this information to AQSC in advance. Travel documents will not be released until received. Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada entering the U.S. are required to bring their passports. For other nationalities, passports are required to enter the U.S. It is your responsibility to check with your local U.S. embassy/consulate to confirm visa requirements and to obtain the proper visa/U.S. alien card (green card).



### June 12: Arrive in Louisville, Kentucky

## June 18: Henderson, Kentucky

With its roots in tobacco, trains, art, and agriculture, Henderson gives a view into the past. Naturalist John James Audubon painted many works for *Birds of American* here. Tour an original Carnegie library that has been serving the residents of Henderson County for over 100 years. Soak in the beauty of Kentucky on a refreshing walk through the John James Audubon State Park or the Audubon Mill Park.

## June 19: Paducah, Kentucky

Uncover a symphony of craft and color in the heartland of America. Celebrate the talent and diversity of the global quilting community at the National Quilt Museum. Learn about Paducah's history through incredible wall-to-wall murals spanning three blocks along the Ohio River, known as the Floodwall Murals. Explore the history of the Paducah Railroad and those who used it before exploring artifacts, exhibits, and interactive displays of marine life and the history of the river at the River Discovery Center.

**Included Hop-On Hop-Off Excursions** Paducah excursions include The National Quilt Museum, Floodwall Murals, Lloyd Tilghman House, Paducah Railroad Museum, and River Discovery Center.

## June 20: New Madrid, Missouri

Take a journey through the first American town in Missouri. Explore the great earthquakes of 1811 and 1812 with seismographic recordings and other historical artifacts. A visit to the stately Bootheel mansion provides you a history lesson in every corner, with original furniture dating back to the 1860s. Experience what it would be like to attend school with all eight grades in the same classroom at the historic Higginson School.
