Discovery

 **AHI Connects: Lao Traditions.** Learn about traditional Lao weaving at a Mekong village, followed by a special Baci ceremony.

 **AHI Connects: Traditional Dance.** Revel in a performance of the graceful Apsara, a traditional Cambodian dance.

 **AHI Connects: Long Khanh A.** Visit a Vietnamese village and see the intricate process of weaving *kramas*, colorful scarves.

Luang Prabang. Your journey reveals beautiful temples and chapels, scenic countryside and traditional Laotian villages.

Tak Bat. Witness saffron-robed monks collecting alms throughout the city.

Siem Reap. Delight in a tuk-tuk tour of Siem Reap, followed by a dance show.

Temples of Angkor. Over two days, witness the magnificent temples of Angkor, including Angkor Wat with its incredible bas reliefs; the great Angkor Thom, the last capital of the Khmers; Ta Prohm, nestled in a jungle home; and the recently restored Thommanon, host to exquisite carvings.

Wat Hanchey. Visit this peaceful hilltop temple and receive a traditional Buddhist water blessing from one of the monks.

Angkor Ban. Glimpse rural village life while interacting with a local family. Talk with students at a school and visit a monastery.

Phnom Penh. A cyclo ride introduces you to the city. Visit the gilded Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda and National Museum.

Killing Fields and Genocide Museum. An expert guide provides insight during a solemn visit to Tuol Sleng and the Cheung Ek Killing Fields' memorial and museum.

Culinary Experiences. Learn about traditional foods — including spring rolls and local, tropical fruits — during demonstrations.

Cu Lao Gieng. Board a sampan and cruise to a 19th-century cathedral. Visit a family-run workshop to see how rowboats are built.

Sa Dec. Glide through the canals on a sampan. Visit the home of Hyun Thuy Le and stroll through the town's market.

Vinh Long. Visit a rice factory to see how paper, wine and candy are made from this humble grain, followed by a visit to a senior home run by Buddhist nuns.

Tien Loi Island. Witness day-to-day life in the river delta and visit quiet Tien Loi island.

A City at War. Explore Saigon's history while visiting the Reunification Palace, city hall and War Remnants Museum.

Ben Thanh market. Experience daily life at Ben Thanh Market. See flowers, fruits, silk, lacquerware and many handicrafts.
