Begin your days with early morning game drives and experience afternoon game drives as daylight gives way to dusk and the setting sun illuminates the wilderness. Descend in a four-wheel drive land cruiser into the 12-mile-wide Ngorongoro Crater, a UNESCO World Heritage-designated Conservation Area.

Stay in deluxe, award-winning Serena Lodges, ideally located for optimal wildlife observation and game drives. These small group safaris, with a maximum of seven passengers per vehicle, are led by safari guides who offer insight into Tanzania's ecosystem as you follow the habitual patterns of the Big Five—African savanna elephant, Cape buffalo, leopard, lion and black rhinoceros.


ANCIENT RHYTHMS OF THE SERENGETI

A UNESCO World Heritage Site

Home to the Big Five, the “endless plains” of Serengeti and its abundant diversity of natural habitats set the scene for a seasonal migration unlike any other in the world. Spanning nearly 6,000 square miles of Tanzania and Kenya, this unique ecosystem encompasses the adjacent Ngorongoro Conservation Area and Kenya’s Maasai Mara National Reserve. A spectacular profusion of wildlife harmoniously coexists with semi-nomadic Maasai herders and warriors who have roamed its trackless grasslands for centuries. The Maasai have fought to maintain their ancestral traditions and have successfully secured pasturing and grazing rights in several national parks. The key to the vitality of the Serengeti lies in the seasonal migrations of wildlife in a rhythmic cycle triggered by mvua ndefu (long rains) and mvua fupi (short rains). By November of each year, the Serengeti’s savannas have been replenished with a fresh growth of succulent grasses, herbs and shrub foliage. Splinter herds of wildebeest, zebra, gazelle and other grazing animals begin yet another southerly 620-mile-long journey from the Maasai Mara to the Serengeti, returning for the January through March calving season—the optimal time to view the wildlife in Tanzania. The cycle reverses in May, at the end of the mating season, as a new generation of these incredible herds trek north, repeating nature’s pageant of migration and birth in a phenomenon now regarded as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa.

Arusha, Tanzania
Day 2

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport near the city of Arusha, the gateway to Tanzania's renowned Northern Safari Circuit. Transfer to the colonial-style, deluxe ARUSHA SERENA HOTEL, nestled in the lush foothills of Mount Meru with views of tranquil Lake Duluti.

Arusha/Tarangire
Day 3

Transfer to the Arusha Coffee Plantation to enjoy lunch. Continue to the deluxe MARAMBOI TENTED LODGE, ideally located just outside of Tarangire National Park on the shores of Lake Manyara. Enjoy the Welcome Reception and dinner at the lodge.

Tarangire National Park
Day 4

Rise with the African sun for a game drive following breakfast. After lunch at Tarangire Safari Lodge, watch for elephants gathering near a riverbed and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle and eland grazing nearby. Tarangire is home to large herds of elephants that roam under a canopy of century-old baobab trees. See wildlife along the banks of the Tarangire River. Try to spot the stocking-thighed ostrich and the kori bustard,

the world's heaviest flying bird and found only in Africa. Keep a keen eye out for lion and cheetah on your afternoon game drive.

Lake Manyara National Park
Day 5

Enjoy an early morning walking safari to the banks of Lake Manyara and look for a vast array of wildlife. After breakfast, transfer to the LAKE MANYARA SERENA SAFARI LODGE, ideally located near Lake Manyara National Park and the Great Rift Valley.

Following lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. Traverse acacia woodland and bushland in search of hippopotamus and brilliantly hued flamingo. Comb the landscape for troops of baboons and blue monkeys scampering along tree branches. Watch for Cape buffalo, wildebeest, elephant and giraffe meandering the grassy floodplain and prides of lion basking in the sun.

Lake Manyara/Ngorongoro Conservation Area
Day 6

Following breakfast, transfer to the edge of the Great Rift. Visit the Kibaoni Primary School, the first public primary school in Tanzania with a library, funded by the nonprofit Kibaoni Primary School Foundation. Meet the principal and view the school's classrooms and library, compiled by book donations from visitors.





Listen for elephants communicating human-like emotions; they are one of the most intelligent animals on Earth.

Following a scenic transfer to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, check into the deluxe, award winning **NGORONGORO SERENA SAFARI LODGE**, ideally situated on the edge of the magnificent crater. Each guest room offers famed views of the stunning crater floor, a wildlife haven.

Ngorongoro Conservation Area Day 7

After breakfast, a four-wheel drive land cruiser will take you on the 2,000 foot descent to the floor of Ngorongoro Crater, a remarkable sanctuary for over 25,000 mammals and hundreds of bird species. Born from the collapse of a massive volcano over two million years ago, the 12-mile-wide caldera shelters a perennial wildlife migration across diverse habitats: savannas, forests, marshlands, salt pans and a soda lake.

Cape buffalo, one of Africa's Big Five, thrive in most grassland habitats within 12 miles of a watering hole.

With bountiful grass and a permanent water supply, the crater floor supports herds of grazing animals that attract lion, leopard and cheetah. Look for zebra, wildebeest, gazelle, Cape buffalo, elephant, eland, black spotted hyena and jackals. Watch for critically endangered black rhinoceros and hippopotamus seeking refuge from the midday sun in Ngoitokitok Springs.

Spot numerous indigenous species of birds including ostrich, augur buzzard and the endangered gray crowned crane, and thousands of flamingos who converge on Ngorongoro's Lake Magadi. After a morning of game tracking, stop for a picnic lunch at the crater floor amid the flora and fauna of this rare ecosystem.

Ngorongoro Conservation Area/ Oldupai Gorge/ Serengeti National Park Day 8

Following breakfast, enjoy game viewing opportunities en route to Oldupai Gorge, the "cradle of mankind," one of the world's most important archaeological sites and the wellspring of our DNA. Here, Louis and Mary Leakey's paleoanthropological work was made famous in 1959, when Mary unearthed the 'Zinj' skull of *Paranthropus boisei*, an early hominin that proved invaluable to the study of human evolution. A year later, the Leakey family also discovered a 1.8-million-year-old *Homo habilis*. Meet the

local curator for a discussion. See the lavish fauna of this mammal-dominated ecosystem including Thomson's gazelle, giraffe, cheetah and leopard.

Check into the deluxe SERENGETI SERENA SAFARI LODGE located within the park's boundaries, with prime proximity to its largest year-round concentration of wildlife.

Serengeti National Park Day 9 and Day 10

An early morning hot-air balloon flight option, conditions permitting, offers an exceptional aerial perspective of the Serengeti's plains.

Experience a sublime spectacle of nature surrounded by herds of wildebeest, Grant's gazelle, topi, zebra and Cape buffalo—only a fraction of more than two million animals following the rhythm of Africa's seasons in a 1,800-mile annual trek through the Serengeti. Morning and afternoon game safaris afford opportunities to witness the Big Five.

Traverse savannas and woodlands which support the abundance of grazing animals and scan the plains for granite *kopjes* (outcrops) favored by large cats, especially lion and leopard. Enjoy prolific birdwatching possibilities with more than 500 species present, including European and North African migratory birds, and see the breeding plumage of resident species.

Enjoy the Farewell Reception and dinner in the lodge on evening of Day 10.

Serengeti National Park/Arusha Day 11

Enjoy breakfast in the lodge before your privately chartered flight over the African landscape to Arusha. Continue to the Arusha Serena Hotel for lunch and day-room accommodations. This evening, transfer to the airport for your return flight to the U.S.


